As a result of the reverse stock split, each EYES Common Share will be converted into the right to receive 0.125 (New) Second Sight Medical Products, Inc. Common Shares. The reverse stock split will become effective before the market open on January 6, 2020.

Upon determination of the cash in lieu amount, OCC will require Put exercisers and Call assignees to deliver the appropriate cash amount.
