Direxion Daily Russia Bull 3X Shares (RUSL) has announced a 1-for-6 reverse stock split. As a result of the reverse stock split, each RUSL Share will be converted into the right to receive approximately 0.166667 (New) Direxion Daily Russia Bull 3X Shares. The reverse stock split will become effective at the market open on December 23, 2014.

PRICING

Until the cash in lieu amount is determined, the underlying price for RUSL1 will be determined as follows:

$$\text{RUSL1} = 0.166667 (\text{RUSL})$$

DELAYED SETTLEMENT

The RUSL component of the RUSL1 deliverable will settle through National Securities Clearing Corporation (NSCC). OCC will delay settlement of the cash portion of the RUSL1 deliverable until the cash in lieu of fractional RUSL shares is determined. Upon determination of the cash in lieu amount, OCC will require Put exercisers and Call assignees to deliver the appropriate cash amount.
