Global X Silver Miners ETF (SIL) has announced a 1-for-3 reverse stock split. As a result of the reverse stock split, each SIL ETF Share will be converted into the right to receive approximately 0.333333 (New) Global X Silver Miners ETF Shares. The reverse stock split will become effective before the market open on November 18, 2015.

DELAYED SETTLEMENT

The SIL component of the SIL1 deliverable will settle through National Securities Clearing Corporation (NSCC). OCC will delay settlement of the cash portion of the SIL1 deliverable until the cash in lieu of fractional SIL Shares is determined. Upon determination of the cash in lieu amount, OCC will require Put exercisers and Call assignees to deliver the appropriate cash amount.
