U.S. Energy Corporation (USEG) has announced a 1-for-6 reverse stock split. As a result of the reverse stock split, each USEG Common Share will be converted into the right to receive approximately 0.166667 (New) U.S. Energy Corporation Common Shares. The reverse stock split will become effective before the market open on June 22, 2016.

PRICING

Until the cash in lieu amount is determined, the underlying price for USEG1 will be determined as follows:

$$\text{USEG1} = 0.166667 (\text{USEG})$$

DELAYED SETTLEMENT

The USEG component of the USEG1 deliverable will settle through National Securities Clearing Corporation (NSCC). OCC will delay settlement of the cash portion of the USEG1 deliverable until the cash in lieu of fractional USEG Shares is determined. Upon determination of the cash in lieu amount, OCC will require Put exercisers and Call assignees to deliver the appropriate cash amount.
